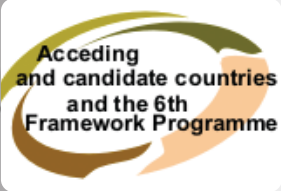


"ACCEDING AND CANDIDATE COUNTRIES AND THE 6th FRAMEWORK PROGRAMME"

The conference was organized by the European Commission - General Direction for Research, in collaboration with the Romanian Ministry of Educations and Research and the Romanian Academy. The 6th FP Projects ROMNET-ERA, ROINTERA and RoDi were also involved in the conference organization.

This conference intended to assure direct information for researchers from Acceding and Candidate Countries (ACC) in order to increase their participation in the 6th FP.



The main topics of the Conference:

- The challenge of Enlargement;
- Integrating Acceding and Candidate Countries in the 6th FP;
- Analysis and Action Plan for a better participation of the Acceding and Candidate Countries in the 6th FP;
- The "state of the art" of the cooperation in the 6th FP;
- Action Plan for a better participation of the Acceding and Candidate Countries in the 6th FP (New instruments - new opportunities - IP, NoE; Mobility; SMEs - a priority for FP6; Building strong consortia; How to prepare and manage EU proposals and contracts).

"An Action Plan for ACC: Information, awareness and training activities (information on FP6/work programmes/calls for proposals, promotion of CCs competencies, support to participation in conferences and in preparing proposals); Organisation (networks of high quality centres, network the NCPs); Proposals stimulation (brokerage events, measures in support of SMEs); Other (evaluation of RTD systems and policies, prospective studies for defining research policies etc.)." Collective Research is the research carried out by Research Performers on behalf of industrial associations or groupings on themes of interest to large sectors and communities of SMEs, with the objective to expand the knowledge base of large communities of SME and therefore, to improve their general standard of competitiveness."
