





#### The 2009 Recovery Plan

Adopted by the EC on 26 Nov 2008 and endorsed by the EU Council on 11-12 Dec 2008

Includes 'smart investment' in research

'To support innovation in the manufacturing, construction and automotive sectors, which have recently seen demand plumet as a result of the crisis and which also face significant challenges in the transition to the green economy...'

Three Public-Private Partnerships (PPPs)

Objective: to promote the convergence of public interest with industrial commitment and leadership in determining strategic research activities





#### The 2009 Recovery Plan

#### The 3 Public Private Partnerships (PPPs) research activities:

"Factories of the future" initiative Indicative budget: € 1.2 billion

"Energy-efficient buildings" initiative Indicative budget : € 1 billion

"Green Cars" initiative Indicative budget : € 1 billion

Funding by European Commission: ~50% Budget committed over 4 years (2010-2013)

10 page proposal: S&T content + expected impact

2 pages: consortium+estimated financial resources

Provisional closing date for Second Stage Submission:

18 MAY 2010

#### Ø Coordination & Support Actions (CSA)

Closing date of Single Stage Submission:

2 FEB 2010

Publication: 30-31 LUG 2009 (single stage procedure)

Provisional Deadlines:

Factories of the Future (NMP): 3-4 NOV 2009

Energy Efficient Buildings (NMP): 3-4 NOV 2009

Green Cars (Joint call NMP-ENERGY-ENV-SST): 14 Jan 2010

Additional funding in the ICT workprogramme/calls.



#### ØEuropean Technology Platforms (ETPs)

Contribute to defining visions, <u>Strategic Research</u> <u>Agenda</u>, roadmaps, in particular in research areas of special industrial relevance.

Universities played crucial role in defining the SRAs and (17% of stakeholders are from Universities).

31 ETPs have been launched, covering a wide range of technological challenges.

Most of these are reaching the implementation stage.

#### ØJoint Technology Initiatives (art. 169 of the Treaty)

Some ETPs SRAs are implemented through Joint Technology Initiatives (JTIs).

Open to industry, incl. SMEs, research institutes and universities.
